#### Introduction

Built in 1792, the Theatre Royal in Dumfries is the oldest theatre in Scotland. Within its walls are 232 years of social, literary and dramatic heritage, woven together to create an historic legacy both for Dumfries and for the whole of Scotland. The theatre has been owned and managed since 1960 by the Guild of Players. A major refurbishment in 2015 has allowed the Guild of Players to considerably expand the programme at the theatre, including community, education, and heritage work. The Guild of Players is a Scottish Charity (SCO01963) and Company Limited by Guarantee (SC35841).

# **Key Tasks**

- Directly responsible to the Education and Youth Engagement Officer (EYE).
- Planning and leading teaching sessions for the GOPYT. This includes liaising with the EYE Officer and Workshop Assistant on plans.
- Making sure that all lessons are planned out and all resources needed are communicated to the EYE before a session.
- Caring for the wellbeing of the young people attending the sessions.
- Organising, along with the Education and Youth Engagement Officer, any other plans the GOPYT have that they are directly involved in.
- Participating in evaluating the activities of the sessions after a block or workshops.
- Noting to the EYE whenever they are unable to attend a session in advance, unless otherwise stated.
- Be able to submit a PVG check with Disclosure Scotland and undertake any relevant training.

- Interest or experience in directing.
